WARWICK RESOURCES COMPLETES SECOND DRILLING PROGRAMME

KEY POINTS

- **Completion of second drilling programme at Jimblebar and Copper Range**
- **Assay results expected from early October**
- **New drilling programme to commence first week of October**
- **Resignation of Company Secretary**

Diversified Pilbara explorer Warwick Resources Limited (ASX:WRK) today announced the completion of its second drilling programme at the Company's 100% owned Jimblebar and Copper Range projects near Newman.

At Jimblebar, seven RC drill holes tested extensions to high grade gold mineralisation identified at the Sunny South prospect in the Company's previous drilling programme. Disseminated sulphides were intersected in all seven holes over a strike length of 350 metres. At Jimblebar, sulphides are an indicator of proximity to gold mineralisation.

Warwick Resources Director Bruce McQuitty said intersecting disseminated sulphides was a positive start.

"These results are encouraging for Warwick Resources' shareholders however we look forward to receiving assay results in early October," Mr McQuitty said.

At Copper Range, nine RC drill holes were completed, targeting EM conductors, outcropping copper mineralisation and extensions to the Copper Knob prospect. Two out of three drill holes targeting EM conductors intersected broad intervals (23-25m) of disseminated sulphide mineralisation (2-10% pyrrhotite-pyrite-chalcopyrite), including one metre of massive sulphide from 120m depth in drill hole WRKRC28 at Copper Hill. The massive sulphide mineralisation, which is predominantly pyrrhotite (iron sulphide), occurs near the margin of an ultramafic intrusive.

Assay results from the Copper Range are due in late October.

In the first week of October, Warwick will commence a new drilling programme including the first pass RC drilling of the Company's channel iron, chromite and nickel projects in addition to scout aircore drilling to define further gold targets along the Jimblebar mineralised trend.

We regret to advise that Lyn Tomlinson has resigned as Company Secretary for personal reasons. The Board thanks Ms Tomlinson for her contribution and wishes her well in her future endeavours. The Board has appointed Will Burbury as acting Company Secretary.
