### WARWICK RESOURCES TO COMMENCE AIRBORNE SURVEYS

Pilbara explorer, Warwick Resources Limited (ASX:WRK) advises that airborne magnetic and radiometric surveys have commenced on the company's 100% owned Woggaginna and Nickel Hills projects, near Newman in Western Australia.

Thomson Aviation have been contracted to fly fixed wing magnetic and radiometric surveys at Woggaginna (143km<sup>2</sup>) and at Nickel Hills (230km<sup>2</sup>). The surveys are to be completed on 100m spaced lines and 35m flying height.

Technical Director Bruce McQuitty said the airborne surveys will enable the Company to focus its copper, nickel and uranium exploration.

The company is fortunate to have secured Thompson Aviation to undertake the surveys at short notice.

A more detailed helicopter-borne magnetic and radiometric survey is scheduled to be flown over the Copper Range project in August 2007.

Information from the surveys will supplement and enhance historical geophysical data from Warwick's projects which has been processed and interpreted by Southern Geoscience Consultants.

The Company has only recently commenced follow up of the many targets generated from this work and is experiencing a high initial success rate.

This follows the successful maiden RC drilling programme at Copper Range and Jimblebar which last month identified the spectacular gold intersection of **1m @ 144g/t Au** within **8m @ 20.4 g/t Au**.

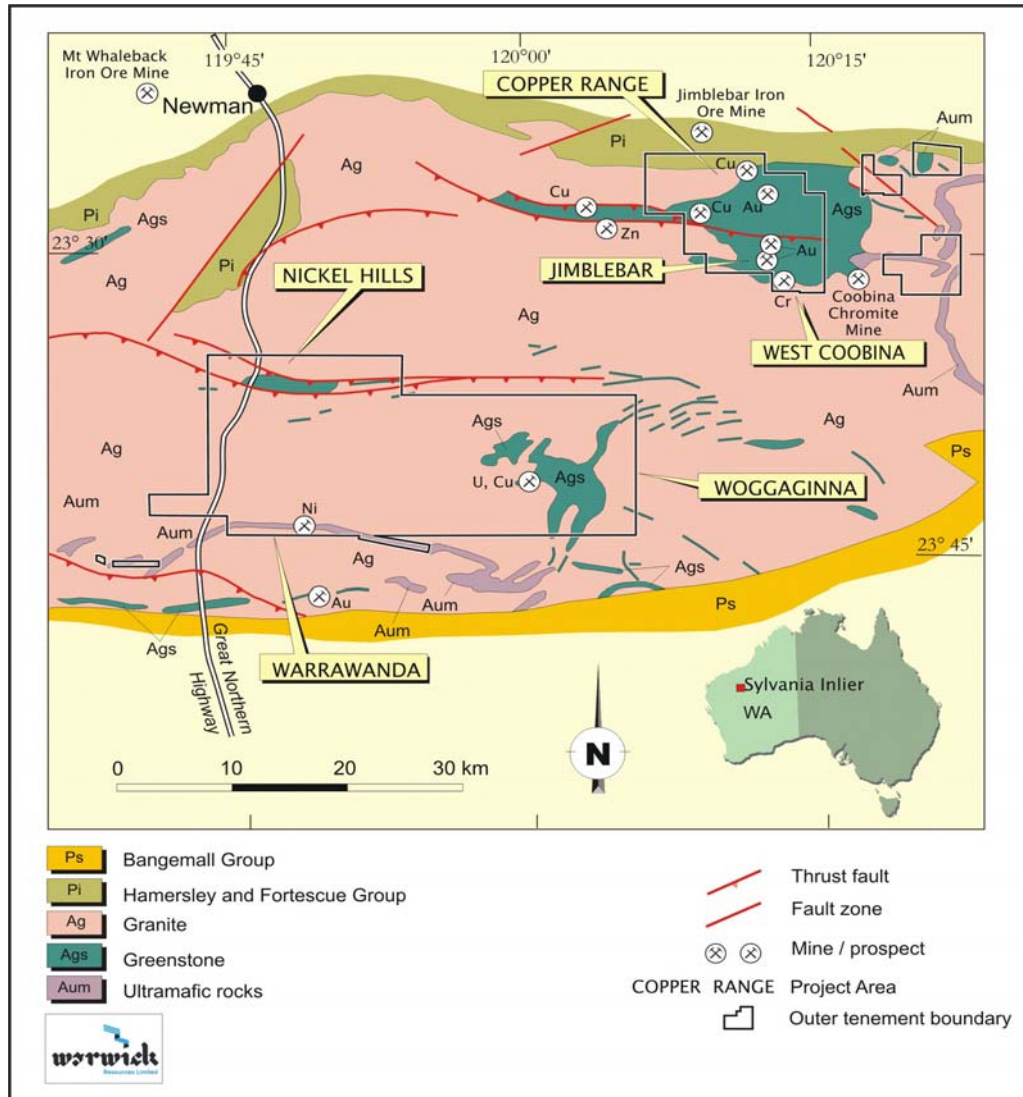

## About Warwick Resources

Warwick Resources is headquartered in Perth, Western Australia and listed on the ASX in February 2007. The company has a diverse asset portfolio and is engaged in an aggressive exploration program in the Pilbara region of Western Australia, close to world class iron ore mines and major infrastructure near Newman.

Warwick Resources strategy is to advance exploration projects with pre-established mineralisation in high value commodities which have significant prospects for discovering further mineralisation and can be developed quickly into commercial operations.

The Company is developing a number of highly prospective mineral projects near Newman, consisting of large consolidated tenement blocks with a total area of more than 700km<sup>2</sup>. The northern block comprises gold, copper, chromite and channel iron projects and the southern block comprises two nickel sulphide projects and a base metals and uranium project. These tenements are located south of BHP Billiton's Jimblebar iron-ore mine and south-west of Consolidated Minerals' Coobina chromite mine.
